





To try to copy someone else is to reject the person God designed you to be. You have the potential to be a unique servant of God. This workshop develops insights into discovering who God made you to be.



Mitchell and Linda Tolle, the Senior Pastors at Man O War Church, started a small business in Berea, Kentucky in the fall of 1980. 



Who Are We?

83% of all Southern Baptist churches report a Sunday School attendance of fewer than 125, most of these churches have bivocational pastors. Other evangelical denominations report similar statistics. This is the target audience of the BSCLN.
